Where does the fundraising money go?

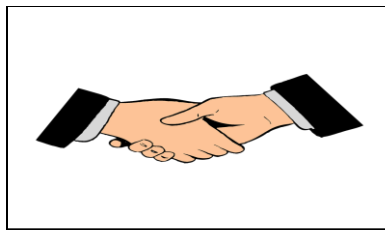

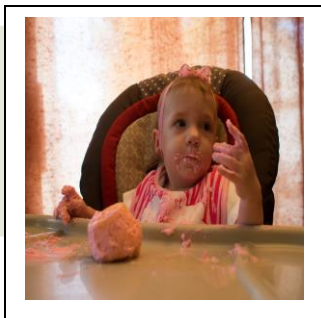

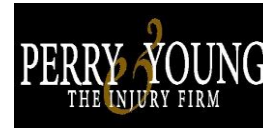
