Formal induction normally takes place at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

#### Finances and Costs

All costs associated with administration of the club, such as meals, membership pins, awards etc., are paid solely by the members through the quarterly charges. Currently, the one-time initiation fee is \$50 and the quarterly charge for dues, meals, and other expenses is approximately \$108. Quarterly charges may vary based on meal costs.

The costs of our service and community projects are covered by fund raising activities, such as auctions, Pancake Days, Annual Golf Tourney, and Adopt a Precinct. Service funds are always separate from club administration funds.
